## LIBRARY

The college has well equipped library, with facility of a reading room. The library is having sufficient collection of text books, reference books, journals, periodicals, monthly news magazines and newspapers. The library aims to develop reading habits among the students. Total books available in the library are 19897 worth Rs.18101094/- only.

- The college library remains open from 10.00A.M.to 5:30P.M. from Monday to Saturday.
- The students should obtain the identity card from the library as soon as he/she takes admission. The identity card is an important document and should be owned safely and brought to college daily.
- No student will be allowed to enter the library without his/her identity card and the same to be shown at the entrance in the library.
- In case, the identity card is lost the student should inform the librarian immediately in writing and apply for duplicate identity card which will be issued on payment of Rs. 25. If the original identity card is found later the student should surrender the duplicate one. A student should not keep two identity cards in his/her possession.
- THE USE OF TWO IDENTITY CARDS IS NOT PERMISSIBLE AND ANY STUDENT VIOLATING THE RULE IS LIABLE FOR SEVERE PUNISHMENT.
- The student will be responsible if his/her identity card is misused in any way by any other student.

## HOSTEL

Iqra Education Society provides hostel facility for the girl students only. The Hostel building is beside the college campus. This facility is available for the girl students studying in college.

## GYMKHANA

The Gymkhana and Sports committee of the college comprises of dedicated teachers and a Director of Physical Education to fulfill the needs of the students for various sports activities. The students participate in various sports at Inter collegiate, University, State and National level and win medals and trophies in different sports activities.

## INTERNET FACILITY

The students of the college can avail the internet facility provided through the Department of Information and Technology from 11 am to 2pm.

## NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

The college runs NSS Unit and every year about 170 students enroll themselves for NSS. They are expected to dedicate 120 hours for social work and to attend the NSS camp during the academic year. **year 2024-25 under NEP 2020.**

The UGC has revised the CBCS and developed a new Curriculum and Credit Framework (CCF) for undergraduate and post graduate programmes. New Education Policy (NEP) is being implemented by the Indian government's ministry of human resource development (MHRD) beginning with the 2023-24 academic year. New Education Policy (NEP-2020) is being implemented by the North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon to all affiliated colleges from academic year 2024-25.

**Objectives of NEP 2020:**

The NEP 2020 aims to transform the education system in India to ensure that it is inclusive, holistic, and flexible. The following are the key objectives of the NEP 2020:

1. **Holistic Development:** The NEP 2020 aims to develop a system that fosters the overall development of students, including cognitive, social, emotional, and physical development.
2. **Equity and Inclusion:** The policy aims to ensure equitable access to education for all, regardless of gender, religion, caste, or socio-economic status. It also focuses on providing quality education to marginalized communities and those with disabilities.
3. **Flexibility:** The NEP 2020 aims to promote a flexible education system that allows students to choose their courses and subjects according to their interests and aptitudes. It also aims to promote multiple entry and exit points in education, making it possible for students to pursue their studies at their own pace.
4. **Quality Education:** The policy aims to ensure that all students receive a quality education on par with international standards. It focuses on improving the quality of teachers, curriculum, and infrastructure in schools and colleges.
5. **Vocational Education:** The NEP 2020 emphasizes the need for vocational education to equip students with the necessary skills and knowledge to succeed in the job market. It aims to integrate vocational education into mainstream education, ensuring that students have the opportunity to choose from a range of vocational courses.

Under NEP, various courses to be learned by student are categorised under the following heads:-

**Course:** A basic unit of education and/or training. It means a paper which is taught for at least one semester as a part of a subject and is a component.

**Major DSC (Mandatory):** The subject represents the main focus of the degree, and the degree will be awarded in that subject.

**Elective Course DSE:** Generally, a course which can be chosen from a pool of courses and which may be very specific or specialized or advanced or supportive to the discipline/ subject of study or which provides an extended scope or which enables exposure to some other discipline/subject/domain or nurtures the candidate's proficiency/skill is called an Elective Course.

**Minor:** is the subject that may complement the Major subject or can have interdisciplinary bandwidth. Minor subjects may be related or unrelated to the Major subject. The Minor subjects may be from the different disciplines of the same DSC Major (Core) faculty or from different faculty altogether.

**GE/OE:** An elective course chosen generally from an unrelated discipline/subject, with an intention to seek multidisciplinary exposure is called a Generic Elective. It is to be chosen compulsorily from faculty other than that of the Major and from the faculty-wise baskets of OE prepared by Colleges.

**VESC:** vocational and skill enhancement courses include

\* SEC (Skill Enhancement Courses) and VSC (vocational skill courses), to be selected from the basket of Skill Courses approved by Colleges. These courses aim to provide students with hands-on training, competencies, proficiency and skills. The courses are expected to enhance skill and employability.

**AEC (Ability Enhancement Courses):**

Includes English: 04 Credits, Modern Indian Language: 04 credits

**VEC (Value Education Courses):** to be chosen from the courses, such as; Understanding India, Environmental Science/Education, Digital and Technological Solutions, the Constitution of India, Ethics and Value Education

**IKS (Indian Knowledge system):** Courses on IKS to be selected from the basket of IKS courses approved by the college. The course is based on the Indian Knowledge system, such as historical accounts of science in India, ancient Ayurveda.

**CC (Co-curricular Courses):** to be chosen from the courses, such as; Health and Wellness, Yoga education, Sports and fitness, Cultural Activities, NSS/NCC and Fine/Applied/ Visual/Performing Arts.

**Academic Bank of Credits (ABC):**

Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) is the initiative of Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (Meity) and Ministry of Education (MoE) respectively. As per National Education Policy 2020, the Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) has been envisaged, to facilitate the academic mobility of students with the freedom to study across the higher education institutions in the country with an appropriate "credit transfer" mechanism from one programme to another, leading to attain a Degree/ Diploma/ PG diploma, etc.,

## ADMISSION ELIGIBILITY FOR DIFFERENT COURSES

### BACHELOR OF ARTS (B.A.)

1. A candidate who has passed the HSC Examination of Maharashtra State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or an equivalent examination of any other statutory Board or University with English shall be eligible for admission to F.Y.B.A.
2. A candidate who has passed D.Ed., course with English shall be eligible for admission to F.Y.B.A.

### BACHELOR OF SCIENCE (B.Sc.)

A candidate who has passed Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination of the Maharashtra State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or an equivalent examination of any other Secondary Board or University with English and any three subjects out of (1) Physics (2) Chemistry (3) Biology (4) Mathematics (5) Geography, Shall be eligible for admission to the F.Y.B.Sc.

However, a candidate who has passed with English and three subjects in the Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination in Science held by the Maharashtra State (i.e. with form number 17 of Boards) is not eligible for admission to F.Y.B.Sc. Class.

**Note:** A student who has passed diploma examination conducted by Board of Technical Education, Maharashtra State is eligible for admission to F.Y.B.A. and F.Y.B.Sc.

## ADMISSION PROCEDURE

A student seeking admission has to submit application for admission in the prescribed form. The application form should be filled carefully. Incomplete or incorrect form will not be accepted.

1. Admission to F.Y.B.A. /B.Sc. / M.A. I Classes & M.Sc.is made strictly on merit and according to the Govt. Resolution no USG - 2003 / (33/03)/1to9/visit-4, letter 16th April 2003.
2. The college admissions are managed online by MKCL.
3. For admission in F.Y. Classes, eligibility form, original mark sheet, leaving certificate and its true copies are necessary. Admission will not be confirmed unless eligibility is obtained from the KBC North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. The students of S.Y.and T.Y. classes should attach to the admission form, the attested copy of mark sheet of the previous examination.
4. External students of the other Universities are not eligible for admission.
5. Students from other colleges within the jurisdiction of KBCNMU must produce T.C. at the time of admission in the college.
6. Without giving any reason/s the college can refuse the admission to any of the students.
